

TRAINING PATHWAYS

Training pathways are a form of more advanced training split across several modules. To date, two pathways are available, although only the first part of 'Introduction to monitoring systems' is online at the moment.

The last of these seven online training courses is on blended learning. This is the online part of the training on gender-based violence (GBV) in crisis settings. Previously a five-day in-person training course, it now comprises the equivalent of two days of online training and three days face to face.
